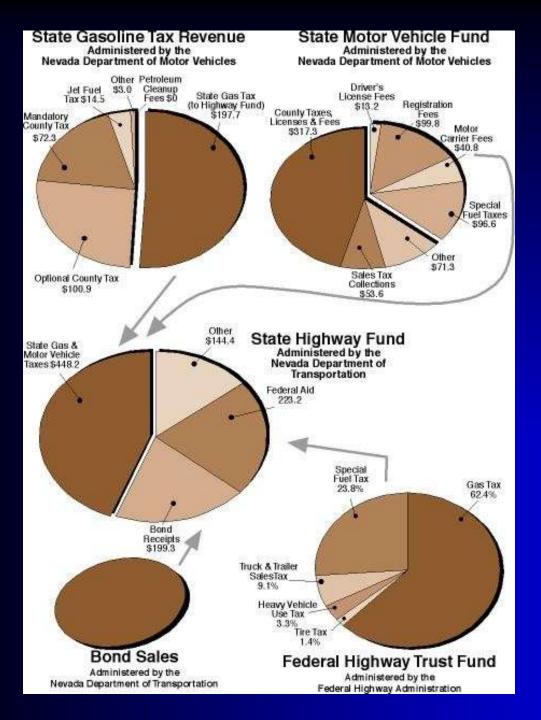

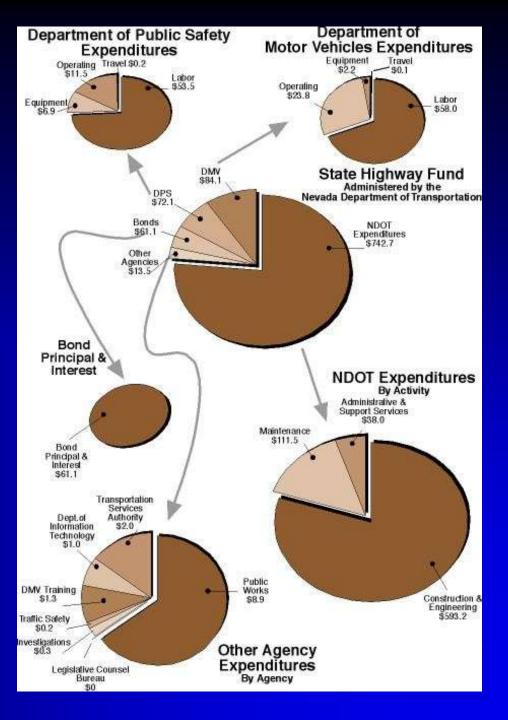


State Highway Fund Revenue Sources

Under AB 595

Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority will contribute \$20 million per year from room taxes.

Clark and Washoe counties will reallocate some existing property tax revenue.

Rental car companies will reallocate one-quarter of revenue now generated from imposing a 4% tax.

All to the State Highway Fund for bonding, and all to stay in county of origin.

Demonstration Project Bill AB 524

- ► I-15/US 95 Corridor
- Allows Tolling for Managed Lanes
- Allows Automated Enforcement

Project Provides Reliability
Increased Access Points to Corridor



Other Proposed Legislation

SB 201 – Washoe County WC 5

Indexes the State and Federal portions of the Gas tax raised in Washoe County. Money to be spent in Washoe County. Coordination with NDOT.

SB 368 − Coffin −

Imposes an additional licensing fee on certain heavyweight motor vehicles. (55K)

- Estimated Cumulative Shortfall by 2016 \$5.3 to \$6.7 billion
- Phasing Projects Bonding Annual Revenue Needs
 - 2009 \$15.5m
 - 2016 \$535m
- National with NO changes \$20 billion for 2010 instead of \$40 b Highway trust fund runs out in June
