




Study Area Consists Of 5 Counties Study Area Map – Study Period: 2015-2019



Study Area Zone Index Map: 2015







Scenario B1/B2 employment growth concentrated in 5 Zones







Scenario B2 population growth centered around Reno-Sparks MSA


Total Projected Population Growth Map-Scenario B2, by


