




U.S. Labor Market Continues to See Low Unemployment

Consumer Price Index, US January 2019 – March 2024




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
Cumulative Inflation by Category from January 2021 – March 2024

- Avg weekly earnings: +14%.


Consumer Price Index by Category, US January 2021 – March 2024




But U.S. Wage Growth Has Slowed Across Education Levels




U.S. Median Household Incomes Declined 4.7% from 2019 Peak

U.S. Household Debt Payments as % of Income Increasing









Since 2004 Nevada Employment Has Grown 40% Overall



Nevada's Job Base Has Diversified Over the Decade




Total Nonfarm Job Openings in NV & U.S. Returning to Trend



But NV is Also Among Highest Unemployment Rate in U.S.


State unemployment rates, March 2024, seasonally adjusted

Unemployment Rates Differ Across Nevada








Total Non-Farm Jobs for Las Vegas MSA +9% vs pre-2020




Total Non-Farm Jobs for Reno-Sparks MSA +7.6% vs pre-2020




Vegas Job Mix Changing. Leisure & Hospitality Down. Professional & Business Services Up




Reno-Sparks Job Mix Changing, Leisure & Hospitality Down. Manufacturing Up.



Leisure & Hospitality Remains Strong in Vegas. Construction & Professional Services Emerging




Leisure & Hospitality is Maturing in Reno-Sparks. Trade, Manufacturing & Construction are the Stars.

Will There Be a Recession?

- Recessions Are Difficult to Call
 - Economists have called 9 of the last 5 Recessions
- That Being Said...Recession isn't off the Table
 - Gross Domestic Income vs GDP
- Timing Suggests Q1 2024 as Possible Start of Recession
 Due to Data Delays Likely Won't Know Until Q3 2024
- Recessions are based solely on GDP Growth
 International Events + Government Spending Play Material Factor

What Does a Recession Mean? What Can We Expect?

The Big Question is: "Is the Economy 'Healthy'"
Low Unemployment + Low Labor Force Participation

- Higher Debt, Lower Savings, Stagnant Wages
- Stagflation?? (High Inflation + Unemployment + No Growth)
- I Am Optimistic (about Nevada)
- Nevada Will Do Better Compared to 2008
 Our Labor Market Has Become More Diversified
 - BUT...Still Likely to be Impacted More than Rest of U.S. Given Reliance on Tourism


